Subject: Beating of a boy accused of theft in Siwan

In daily 'Inquilab' dated 15th September, 2014 it is reported that a boy accused of theft was tied to a tree by villagers and then mercilessly beaten. According to the press report he was rescued by the police. Photograph published in the newspaper shows that his hands and feet were tied to the tree and he was beaten in a semi-naked position. This has happened in Raghunathpur Siwan district in the village of Salimpur.

SP, Siwan be issued a notice and directed to file a report before the Commission within two weeks. He shall also try to find out the persons responsible and proceed against them in accordance with law.
